Neuropsychological Assesment has been widely used in the last 30 years in the characterization of dementia associated with AD. Well stablished for identification, staging and tracking for the disease, nowadays the assessment is focused in prevention and early detection. In the Vallecas Project context, a longitudinal multidisciplinary study for early markers in preclinical stages of AD, the Neuropsychology department at CIEN Foundation has four research lines that may contribute to this purpose. In this communication we would like to share our findings and future objectives.
