The Research Center for Neurological Diseases Foundation offers a post-doctoral (Ref: DCLEA II) position at the Reina Sofia Foundation Alzheimer Centre in Madrid, Spain.

The main project focuses on an ongoing longitudinal study of a large cohort of healthy 70-85 year olds, with particular emphasis on those individuals who subsequently develop mild cognitive impairment and Alzheimer's disease.

A strong background in functional brain MRI is required, particularly in network analysis of "resting-state" MRI. Experience in dementia or aging research is desired, with a publication record in this field. Fluent in both English and Spanish language skills is required, and previous post-doctoral training in internationally recognized institutions is also desirable. A background in theoretical neurobiology is also a plus.

The successful candidate will work in a multi-disciplinary environment with full access to a 3T research-dedicated scanner, and be expected to participate in further studies in cognitive neuroimaging, as well as being highly proactive in applying for research grants in the field of aging and dementia. There will be close collaboration with several laboratories of CIBERNED and other research centres.
